Euclid Data Quick Release 1 (Q1)

[Euclid Q1 data](#) will be released on March 19, 2025, by the [ESA Euclid science archive](#) as well as the [complementary archive](#) at the NASA/IPAC Infrared Science Archive (IRSA). The release will include data from a single visit (the [Euclid Wide Survey](#) depth) over the [Euclid Deep Fields](#) (EDFs): EDF North ($\sim 20 \text{ deg}^2$), EDF Fornax ($\sim 10 \text{ deg}^2$), and EDF South ($\sim 23 \text{ deg}^2$).
