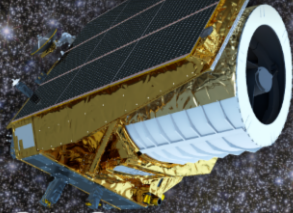

Euclid Quick Data Release 2

[Euclid Quick Data Release 2 \(Q2\)](#) will take place on June 24, 2026. It includes Euclid visible instrument (VIS) images over 4.8 square degrees close to the Galactic Center (marked in red in the image on the right). This will enable accurate mass measurements of microlensing planets found by previous surveys, and provide precursor observations for the Roman Galactic Bulge Time Domain Survey.
